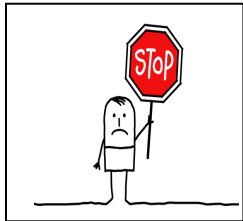


BLOOD AND BODY FLUID EXPOSURE 2105.0375

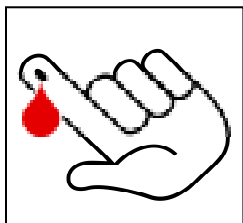
Practitioner/Client Injury Procedure



1. **Stop Service!**
Whenever an unexpected cut, abrasion or injury occurs resulting in blood or body fluids.



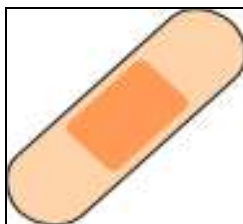
2. Put on glove (s).



3. Clean injury
If possible rinse wound with running water.



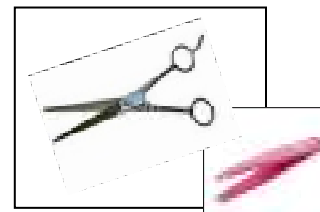
4. Clean with antiseptic solution.



5. Cover with sterile bandage.



6. **PRACTITIONER**—Hand wound must be covered with a glove or finger cover.



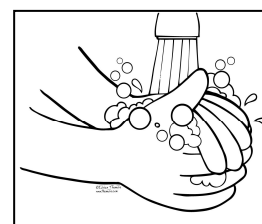
7. Remove from service all contaminated equipment, tools and implements.



8. Clean and disinfect all contaminated surfaces such as counters, chairs, tables.



9. Dispose of all contaminated disposable items in a plastic bag, seal and discard.



10. Wash hands and resume Service.

Following completion of service all contaminated surfaces must be cleaned and disinfected according to law and rule. 2105.0375 Subpart 3 & 4
